DAY ONE - SUNDAY USA / CANADA - TEL AVIV

Non-stop overnight flight to Israel

DAY TWO - MONDAY – TEL AVIV & JERUSALEM

Arrival at Ben Gurion airport in Tel Aviv. Welcome and "Bruchim Habaim".

Our representative will meet you immediately, and after clearing customs, you will meet your guide and driver for a private transfer to Jerusalem, the Holy City. On the way, we visit Rappaport's stunning sculpture of the "Scrolls of Fire". Upon entering Jerusalem, you can honor your heritage with a toast, and recitation of the "Shehechyanu" blessing. Everyone is welcomed at a get-together group dinner at a fine dining restaurant in Jerusalem.

DAY THREE - TUESDAY- JERUSALEM



The day begins with a trip to the top of Mount Scopus to enjoy a thrilling panoramic view of Jerusalem. Then, we enter the Old City via the Zion Gate, and walk through the restored Jewish Quarter, passing the excavated Roman Cardo. Centuries of history reverberate as we visit the Herodian mansions and the Burnt House en route to the revered Western Wall. From here, we will take an exciting walk (by special arrangement for our group) through a newly opened 1200-foot long tunnel, dug at the time of King Herod and used as an aqueduct to bring water to the Temple. A highlight of the day is a visit to the Time Elevator, one of the best attractions in Jerusalem – a dynamic multi-screen "ride" presenting the 3,000-year history of Jerusalem presented by Haim Topol (Fiddler on the Roof). Great fun for the entire family. Tonight you will enjoy an evening including dinner on your own. Overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY FOUR - WEDNESDAY – JERUSALEM

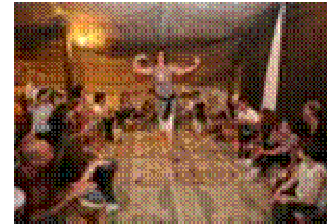
A full day devoted to the New City of Jerusalem. We will start with a special guided tour of the Knesset (Israel's Parliament Building). We will stop by the famous Menorah, the emblem of the State of Israel, and then view the architectural splendor of Israel's Supreme Court Building. On to the Israel Museum; visit the Shrine of the Book housing the Dead Sea Scrolls and stroll through the magnificent Billy Rose Sculpture Garden. Take time to view the inner dynamics of this unique location. Visit the Scale Model of Jerusalem in its new location and see the replica of Jerusalem during the 2nd Temple period. We return to our hotel in Jerusalem. Tonight we will enjoy an exclusive Dine Around Program. Over night in Jerusalem.



DAY FIVE - THURSADY – JERUSALEM – MASSADA – DEAD SEA



Today we start with a drive through the Judean Wilderness to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, 1200 feet below sea level! Our first stop will be at Masada, declared by UNESCO as a world heritage site, where we will ascend by cable car to view the excavations of the Herodian palace, storerooms, bathhouse and water reservoirs. We will also visit the Synagogue and the Beit Midrash. Our guide will tell us about the heroic last battle of the zealots against the Romans. From Masada we will drive to Ein Gedi, where you will hike in this beautiful nature reserve. When you reach the tall waterfall you can even jump into the refreshing water. You will also enjoy the unique sensation of a "float" in the unsinkable Dead Sea. On the way back to Jerusalem we will visit Qumran, and we will view a video presentation telling the story of the Dead Sea Scrolls, how they were written 2000 years ago and how they were found in 1947 by local shepherds.



Back to Jerusalem. After we have refreshed our self at the hotel, we will visit the Land Of Genesis camel farm and biblical tent where we will have a short camel ride and will be treated to an authentic Festive Dinner at Abraham's tent. A night you will never forget! Overnight in Jerusalem. Dress code: casual

DAY SIX - FRIDAY – JERUSALEM – TEL MARESHA – JERUSALEM

We travel to Yad Vashem, Israel's memorial to the Holocaust, for a Yizkor service and a visit to the majestic Children's Pavilion and the brand new Museum. We'll end this part of our visit at the Valley of Destroyed Communities. A stop at Mount Herzl, Israel's military cemetery, will allow us to pay respects at the tomb of Yitzhak Rabin. Then we drive to Ein Karem to view Chagall's famed stained glass windows at the synagogue of the Hadassah Hospital. Participate in an authentic hands on archeological dig at Tel Maresha. Continue to Mahane Yehuda, Jerusalem's marketplace, to share in the spirit of preparation for Shabbat and to enjoy the best Falafel in the country! After dressing for Shabbat, we visit the Western Wall and participate in our unique Kabbalat Shabbat service at the Southern Wall. Shabbat dinner and overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY SEVEN - SATURDAY – JERUSALEM



Begin the day on a walking tour of the Jerusalem Old City, exploring the colorful Jewish Quarter of the city, ending at the Tower of David, where the Museum of the History of Jerusalem beautifully explains the land's 3000-year story. Today, you will have plenty of free time to explore the city or revisit favorite spots from the previous few days. Tonight you will enjoy an evening including dinner on your own. Overnight in Jerusalem.

DAY EIGHT-SUNDAY-JERUSALEM-BEIT-ALPHA-MEGIDDO – TIBERIAS

Today we head North, via Latrun. A visit to the Yad Lashiryon museum provides an opportunity to the children to climb on actual combat tanks from years past. This was the staging area for the Independence War. At the Armour Corps Museum we learn about the battles that secured the road to





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Jerusalem and led to victory. You will reaffirm your connection to the soil of "Eretz Israel", the Land of Israel, by planting a tree with your own hands in one of the JNF young forests. On to Beit Alpha, a wonderful 1,500 year-old synagogue known for its spectacular mosaic floor, where you will enjoy a multimedia presentation. We will visit the Gan Hashlosha Park Reserve where you can swim or simply relax enjoying the green surroundings. This evening we spend time on a cruise followed by a delicious dinner at the famous Decks restaurant on Lake Kinneret. Overnight in Tiberias.



DAY NINE – MONDAY - TIBERIAS – GOLAN HEIGHTS - KUNEITRA – SAFED – TIBERIAS

Drive to Safed, home to the Kabala. This charming town, filled with cobblestone streets, and lined with ancient synagogues and artists' galleries, offers breathtaking views of the entire upper Galilee. We continue to explore the geo-politically vital Golan Heights by Jeep! Travelling off-the-beaten-track roads, we hear about the critical battles fought in this area. At Mt. Bental, we stop at an observation point overlooking Kuneitra and Syria. This site will give us a meaningful perspective of the significance of the Golan Heights. This afternoon is set aside for fun as you River Raft on the Mighty Jordan River. We drive back along the shoreline of the Sea of Galilee, Israel's sole source of fresh water, and one of Israel's favorite vacation spots, to Tiberias, once a rabbinical scholar center. We end this special day with our special Kibbutz home hospitality program, sharing conversation and dinner with the Kibbutz members. Overnight Tiberias.



DAY TEN – TUESDAY - TIBERIAS – ROSH HANIKRA – ACRE – DRUZE VILLAGE – TEL AVIV

We drive to Rosh Hanikra to view the grottos near the Lebanese border. Continuing along the Mediterranean shore to Haifa, we ascend Mount Carmel to behold the spectacular view of the coastline and the magnificent terraced gardens of the Bahai World Center. As a special treat we will visit the Druze Village of Ussifiya to have a traditional lunch with a Druze family to learn about these unique Israeli citizens. From there we continue to vibrant Tel Aviv. Tonight, enjoy another exclusive Dine Around Program. Overnight in Tel Aviv.



DAY ELEVEN – WEDNESDAY - TEL AVIV – REHOVOT –JAFFA- TEL AVIV

We start with a visit to Independence Hall where the state of Israel was declared by David Ben Gurion in May, 1948, then continue to the Museum of the Diaspora on the campus of the Tel Aviv University. It is here that one can find the complete record of the history of the Jewish people. Visit the Ayalon Institute, a secret underground ammunition factory where you will learn of the bravery and ingenuity of pre-state freedom Hebrew fighters. The Institute is situated on the Rehovot Drive to ancient Jaffa where Jonah began his adventure with the whale. Take a short walk through the restored town. Then, enjoy an exploration of Tel Aviv with its narrow byways filled with artist galleries and cosmopolitan shops. Tonight, enjoy a special Farewell dinner and an evening together at a restaurant. Evening ground transfer to airport. Your respective flight back to USA / Canada will depart after midnight.

DAY TWELVE – THURSDAY - TEL AVIV
